



Understand a Web Address Format

Work in pairs. Answer the questions:

- 1. You moved to Ontario and are looking for a family doctor. Which website should you go to? Why? What do the other two extensions mean?
 - A. health.gov.on.ca
 - B. health.com
 - C. health.org

The answer is A since you are looking for a family doctor in the province of Ontario, and '.on' is the extension for the province. B is not correct because .com is for a commercial business; C is also not correct because it is a non-profit organization, and it is also not specific to Ontario.

- 2. You are shopping online. Which store is located in Canada? How do you know? What do the other two extensions mean?
 - A. costco.com
 - B. costco.ca.com
 - C. costco.ca

C is the correct answer since it has the .ca extension which means it is a Canadian website. A is not correct because Costco is an American company and the American Costco website will probably have the .com extension already. B is also not correct because this is not a valid extension. Sometimes a Canadian version of the website will look like this: ca.indeed.com or ikea.com/ca.

- 3. You are going on a family vacation. Which website would you choose to book a flight? Why? What do the other two extensions mean?
 - A. cheapflights.ca
 - B. expedia.com
 - C. cheapair.gov

A is correct because you are departing from Canada and you want to pay in Canadian dollars so booking a vacation on a Canadian site makes sense. B is Expedia's American site and .gov is usually only for American government sites.

- 4. You want to apply for a parent visa to bring your mother to Canada.

 Which website is the official one? How do you know? What do the other two extensions mean?
 - A. canadavisa.com
 - B. canada.ca
 - C. immi.homeaffairs.gov.au

B is correct because you want to look for information from the Canadian government site. A is probably an immigration consultant business website, and C is an Australian government website.




Use the Address Bar

- You don't need to type www.
- Mare sure you get the spelling and punctuation exactly right.
 If you make a mistake, the website won't load.
- Capital letters are not important online.






Search for Information Online

When searching for information online, you can type in any of the three fields:




When the results are loaded, you can choose to see maps, images, news or videos mentioning your keyword.






