Digital skills required for this task	Before doing the assessment, ensure that your students have the digital skills necessary for success in this task. Level(s)	Literacy-CLB 1
Description of learner task	Learners listen to and follow the teacher's instructions and show they understand by doing it on their computer.
Information for the teacher	Task conditions: Each student must have their own computer. Reminder: Teach the skills prior to this assessment. Assessing the digital skills: A content-based answer key does not need to be created because the focus is on digital skills. What is important is how students get to the information, not the information itself. For students with stronger reading skills: have them use the Self-Assessment Checklist to check their digital skills. For students with lower reading skills: the teacher checks their success in the task. Language skills: You are not assessing language skills. If the students do not remember vocabulary in the task instructions or the digital skills checklist, explain it to them again. Reduce the number of instructions as needed, depending on student skill level and what you've covered. Aim for student success! Revise the Assessment Checklist accordingly. There are 2 options for this task: 1 is oral; students listen and follow. 2 is reading; students read and follow the steps.
Instructions for the task	Show the Self-Assessment Checklist to students before doing the task. For Literacy learners, you may omit this and use the Checklist yourself.

Module 4: Online Skills



- Remind the students that the purpose of the task is to check their digital skills. The purpose is <u>not</u> to check their answers nor their language skills.
- Repeat the instructions as often as necessary.
- Suggestion: Have each learner come to one specific computer for the assessment.
- For Option #1: Cut up the strips with the website name and hand this out to students. Then read the script.
- For Option #2: Give the handout of the steps.



Open **Daily Routine** (or point and say "Open this")

Open **Daily Routine-Easy** (or point and say "Open this")

Play the video

Pause the video

Go back (to the homepage)

Open **Health** (or point and say "Open this")

(NB: Students may need to scroll down depending on the computer / laptop)

Open **Dental Health** (or point and say "Open this")

Play the video

Pause the video

Go back (to the home page)


