Description of learner task	Read and follow instructions on how to install an app on the phone.	
Information for the teacher	 Task conditions: Each student must have their own phone. Reminder: Teach the skills prior to this assessment. Assessing the digital skills: A content-based answer key does not need to be created because the focus is on digital skills. What is important is how students get to the information, not the information itself. Have your students use the Self-Assessment Checklist to check their digital skills. When the students finish the task, check that they were able to download the app on their phones. Help them to delete the app if necessary. Language skills: You are not assessing language skills. If the students do not remember vocabulary in the task instructions or the digital skills checklist, explain it to them again. 	
Instructions for the task	 Show the Self-Assessment Checklist to students before doing the task. Remind the students that the purpose of the task is to check their digital skills. The purpose is <u>not</u> to check their answers nor their language skills.
