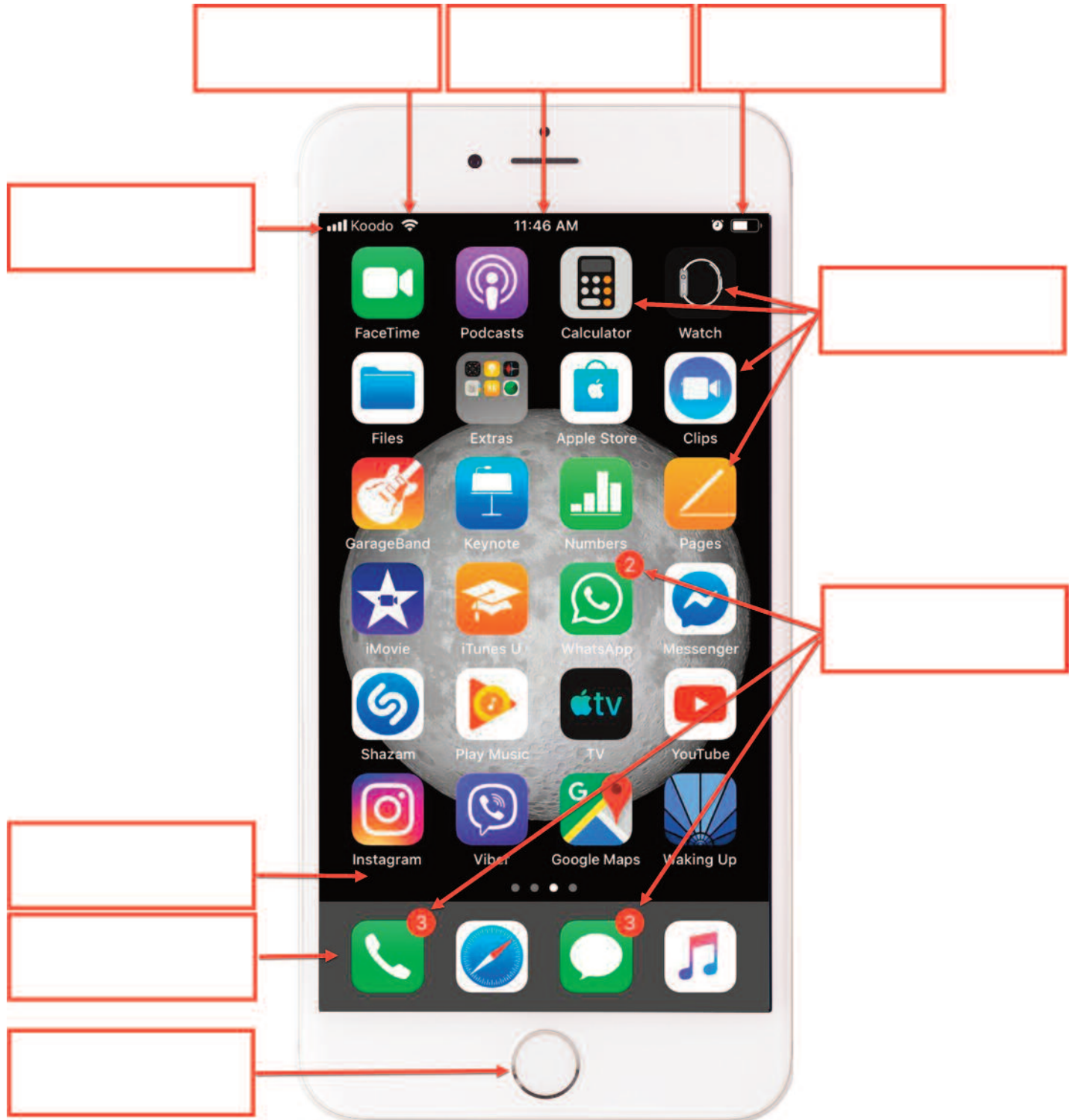

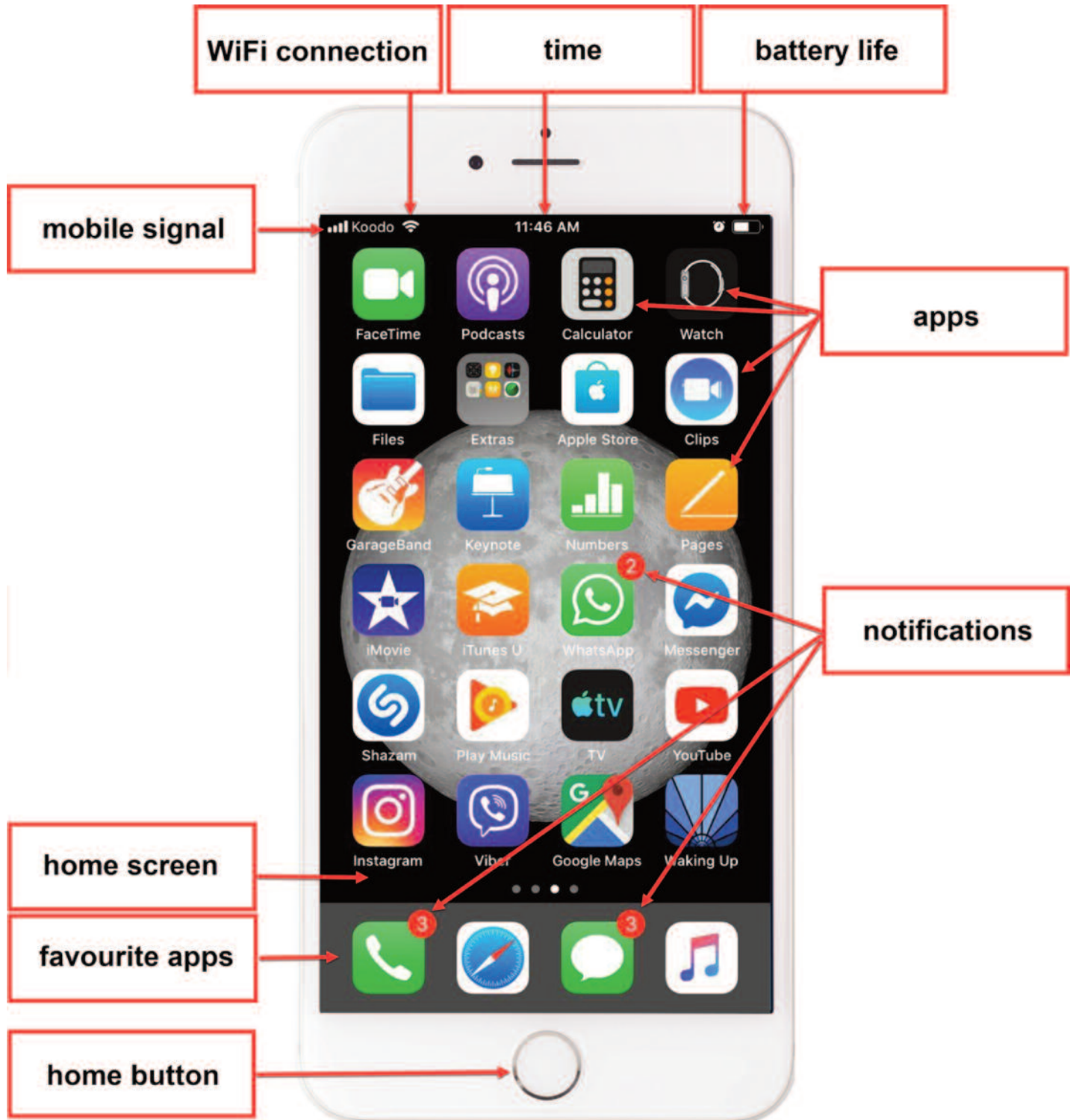

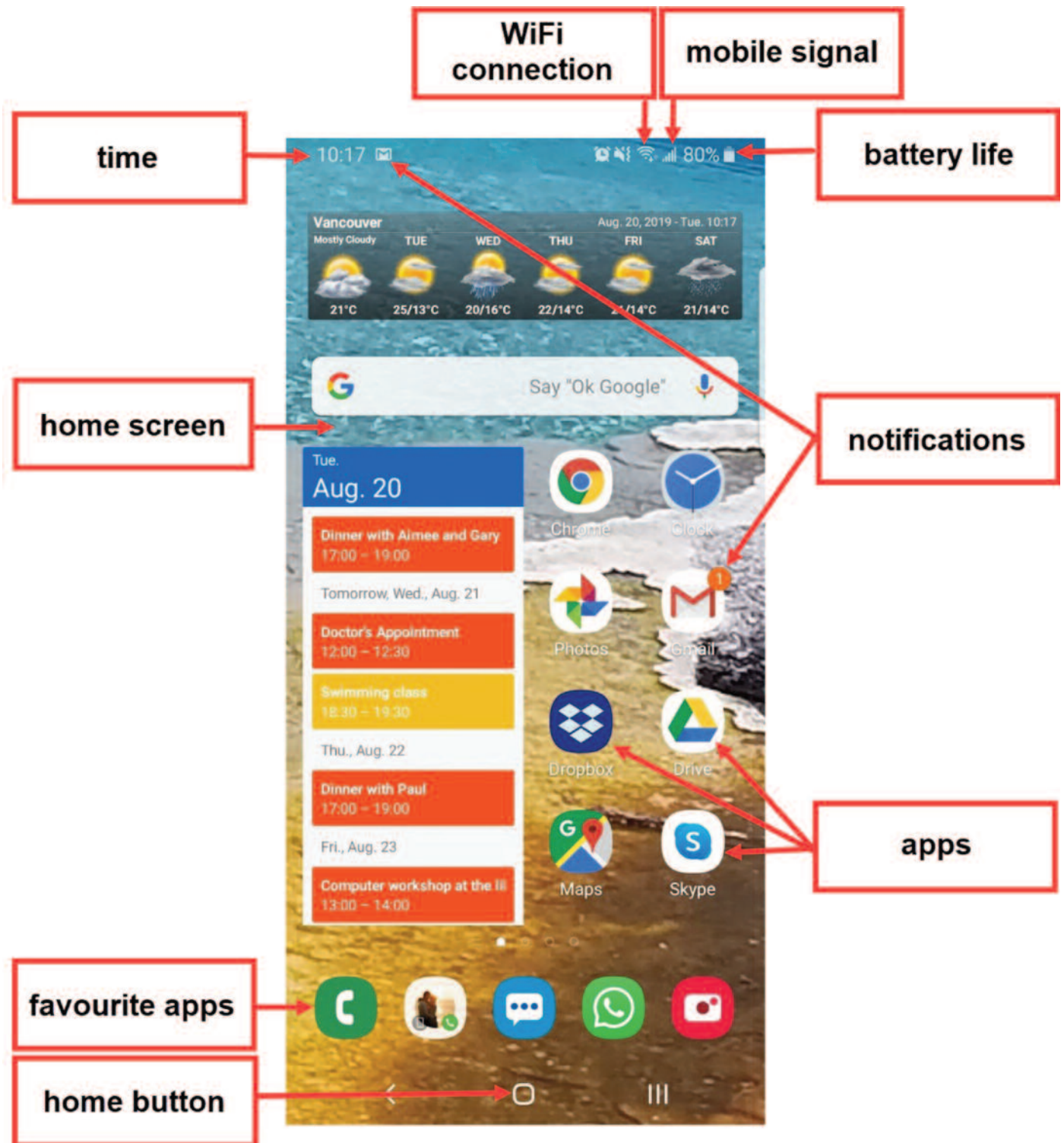

Use the Multi-Touch Screen

1. Find the Maps app on your phone.



2. Tap the app. It opens.

3. Double tap the map. What happens?



4. Double tap the map again. What happens now?

5. Double tap two more times. How close can you get?



6. Use your thumb and your index finger to make the map smaller again.

7. Put your finger on the screen and move it left, right, up, down, and around.



8. Can you find your home on the map? Put your finger on the screen and move the map. When you see your street, use your thumb and index finger to get closer to your home.

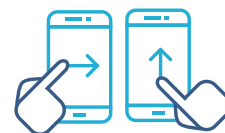


9. Press the Home button and return to the home screen.



10. The Maps app is not closed. Close it.

Android: Tap the home button / button to the right or left of the home button. See all opened apps. Find the Maps app. Swipe to the right / swipe up from the bottom of the screen. The app closes.



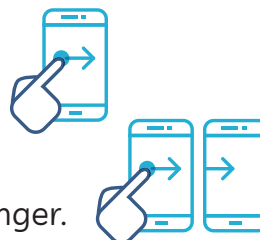
or

iPhone: Quickly tap the home screen button twice. Swipe right or left to find the app. When you find the Maps app, swipe up from the bottom of the screen. The app closes.



10. Find the Maps app again on your home screen. Move the app to a different home screen. Follow these steps:

- 1) Touch and hold the app.
- 2) Move the finger to the right side of the screen.
- 3) Hold it.
- 4) The next screen will open. Move the app there.
- 5) Choose the place on the screen and lift your finger.

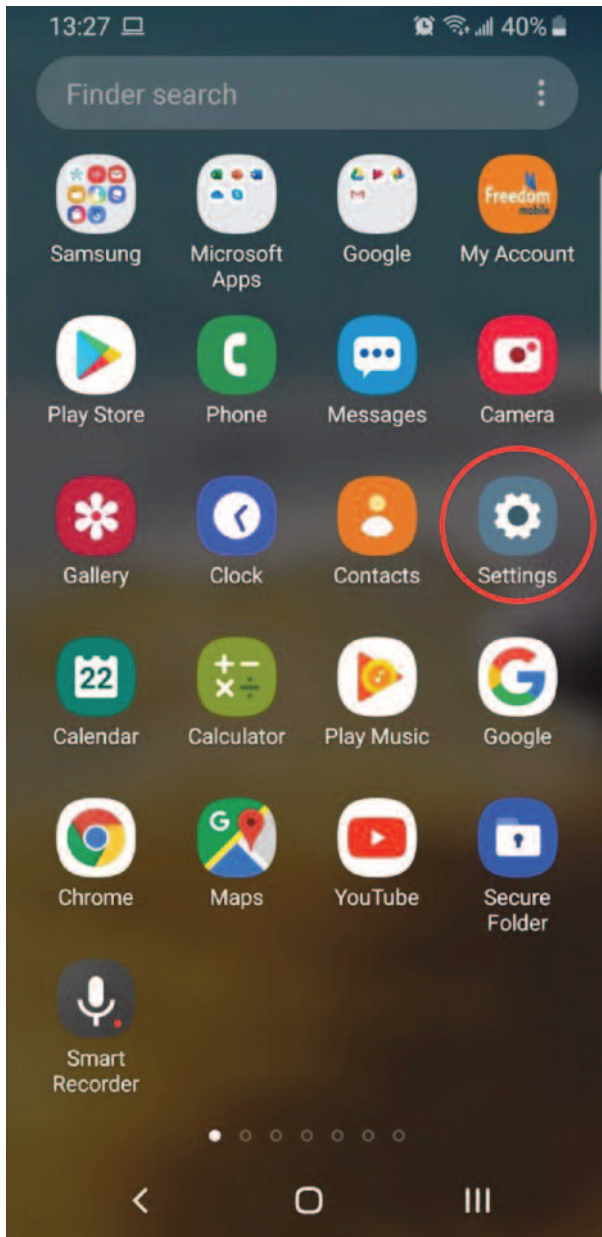

Finally, tap 'Connect'.



You are now connected to WiFi!

Finally, tap 'Join'.



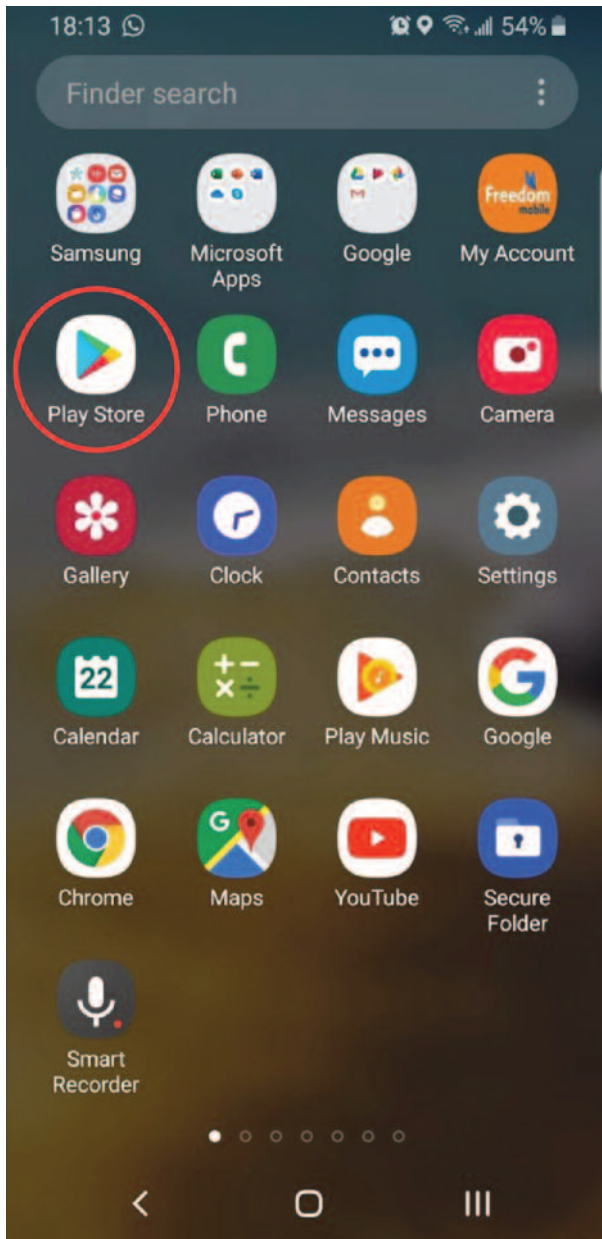
