Digital skills required for this task	<ul> <li>Ensure that your students have the digital skills necessary for success in this task.</li> <li>Skills from other Modules: <ul> <li>Mouse skills: hold the mouse, left click, double click, scroll, different shapes of cursor</li> <li>Navigation: move the mouse around the screen to position the cursor in correct location</li> <li>Keyboarding: type words, numbers, symbols; use Shift and Enter keys</li> <li>Online skills: open a web browser, use the address bar, search for a website</li> <li>Email skills: log in to email account</li> </ul> </li> <li>Skills from Module 7: <ul> <li>Understand weak vs. strong passwords</li> <li>Create a strong password</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
