1. Instructional language in the Lesson

We have given you sample instructional language in the lesson. You don't have to use it but there is a reason we gave it to you. Why do you think we did that ? What do you think are the advantages of using the language more or less as we gave it to you ?

2. Materials-Handouts

Looking at the top of each page of the Visuals & Handouts, you can see there are a few different kinds of "Materials". Some are called "Visual" others are called "Learn-Handout" or "Practice-Handout" Some digital skills also include a "Your Turn-Handout".
